Cold Packs on Head bumps - Recently there has been some discussion regarding applying cool/ice packs to head bumps. The authority has published some guidelines which say we should NOT apply cool/ice packs to bumped heads. The advice here is not to use ice packs or ice at all but to monitor and reassure a child with a minor bumped head. There is a real danger that first aid staff may apply an ice pack to a more significant head injury and this will mask and delay more urgent treatment. School will be following recent guideline for head bumps and using a cold compress, like a clean flannel or towel to help the child feel more comfortable.

Fun Day – Tuesday 16th July Our Fun Day will take place on Tuesday 16th July. This year we have an Olympic theme, so we encourage children to dress up with Olympics in mind, if they wish. It proves to be an action packed, fun morning for us all.

School Dinner Price Increase - From 1st September Catering Leeds are increasing their school meal charge to us. For children in KS2, the school meal price will be going up to £2.75 per child per day to reflect this increase. We are sorry about this, but know that you understand why we need to put the increase in place.
